Baptism of the Lord 11th January 2026



Sunday Scripture Thoughts: In the 2012 film *The Impossible*, the tsunami of Christmas Day 2006 is re-enacted powerfully. The film contrasts the death-dealing and life-giving power of water. In the Baptism of the Lord, Jesus sanctifies the waters through which all those who experience it will die to sin and rise to new life in Him. The pouring of water in baptism has both a death-dealing and life-giving effect. The consequence of this effect is a sharing in the priestly, prophetic and kingly ministry of Jesus, lived out in our specific vocation. Through these waters, God doesn't ask us what we aspire to be. No, through these waters, God invites us to seek His will and become heralds of the Gospel through that specific vocation.
