

Livesimply Thought for the Week: Peace Sunday is celebrated on Sunday 18th January in the UK. We are all encouraged to use the day to reflect on the Pope's message for the World Day of Peace on the 1st January with the theme: Peace be with you all: towards an 'unarmed and disarming' peace. The message addresses the escalation of war, rearmament and fear in international relations, affirming again that nonviolence is the key to peace. Pope Leo reminds us of the Church's opposition to deterrence based on military force and calls for disarmament, dialogue and the conversion of hearts as necessary conditions for a lasting and unarmed peace.
